  - Opportunity to streamline reporting / relieve IR capacity
  - Ability to tell a better, more robust story
  - Better data to inform public policy and advocacy




## **VFA Data Tool**



## **VFA Data Dashboards**

Real-time, dynamic graphs and tables of all of your VFA data.

- Outcomes Dashboard: shows your VFA outcomes in preformatted visual graphs and tables.
- Benchmarking Dashboard: enables colleges to compare their
   VFA data and outcomes to the data and outcomes of colleges
   that have similar demographics




Six-Year Outcomes

Each student in the cohort is counted in only one of the Six-Year Outcomes and the sum of all of the Outcomes will total 100% of the cohort.

The Six-Year Outcomes are:

- Unduplicated
- Hierarchical
- Achieved by the end of six years
- Credentials earned at your college







#### —Two-Year Progress

- Credentials earned at *your* college








## **VFA Data Exports**



#### Six Year Cohort (Fall Students 2007)


These data represent students that entered in the fall of 2007 (or summer before) and their progress by the end of their first two years, i.e. end of 2008-09 academic year.

#### Cohort Types

Different types of students

- A. Main Cohort: fall entering, first time at YOUR college; "all students"
- B. Credential Seeking: earned 12 credits by end of year two
- C. First Time in College: fall entering, first time in college
- \*Students could be in more than one cohort type

#### **Two-Year Progress Measures**

These measures report milestones along the educational pathway and persistence/outcomes by the end of a student's first two years at the college.

The persistence/attainment outcomes by the end of year two provide a snapshot of the cohort's performance. These outcomes are not exhaustive and will not sum to 100% of the cohort. The outcomes are:

- Unduplicated
- Hierarchical
- Achieved at the college by the end of two years

- > VFA membership is calendar year: January 1 December 31
  - BUT sign-ups open the October prior and access is immediate
- Data collection and publishing goes until June 1
- ➤ Dues for the VFA are annual and are assessed based on a college's enrollment (ranging from \$1,000 to \$3,000)
  - Discounts are available for:
    - Early-bird sign-up
    - Multi-college memberships (all colleges in your state or system join)
    - Multi-year memberships (VFA offers one-, two-, and three-year memberships)
    - Discounts can be combined
