Alumnus Spotlight: Van Crawford Encourages Others to Pursue a Fulfilling Power Career

Posted on April 3, 2019

On Oct. 10, 2018, a Category 4 hurricane slammed into Mexico Beach, Fla., having attained peak winds of 155 mph. The hurricane leveled homes, toppled trees, and downed power lines, leaving some roads impassable. The devastation from Hurricane Michael left 271,998 homes and businesses in Florida's Panhandle without power, so more than 7,500 workers from 15 states and Canada were called upon to restore power to the region as quickly as possible. Van Crawford, vice president of operations at Peace River Electric Cooperative (PRECO) in Wauchula and an SFSC alumnus, was one of them.

"I went to assist the Gulf Coast Electric Cooperative in restoration efforts three days after the hurricane hit," Crawford said. "They had two districts, and I was put in place to be the coordinator of one of those

AFC Scholarship Criteria

AFC Scholarship - \$150 Award

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be an AFC member or dependent of a member.
- Applicant must have a college level GPA of at least 2.5. Entering freshmen must have a high school GPA of at least 2.5.
- Applicant must provide proof of enrollment.
- Applicant must submit a complete scholarship application within the first 30 days of the term for which the scholarship is being requested.
- The applicant must reapply for this scholarship each term.

Additional eligibility for Dependents

- The Membership Status Questionnaire must be completed by the AFC member.
- The Dependent must be enrolled at least half-time (6 credit hours or 240 clock hours per term).
- The Dependent must be pursuing a post-secondary degree or certificate program at an accredited institution.

Selection Process:

- The Recipient will be chosen by the AFC Scholarship Committee.
- Scholarship applications from members will receive priority over those from dependents.
- Recipients must submit final semester grades in order to be eligible for future awards.

AFC Foundation Scholarship - \$500 Award

Minimum SFSC Foundation Requirements:

- The Applicant must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- The Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- The Applicant must be a SFSC student enrolled at least half-time (6 credit hours or 240 clock hours per term) at SFSC.
- Submit a complete scholarship application. The Applicant who submits an application with information omitted will not be considered for a scholarship.
- The Applicant must have a college GPA of at least 2.75 and meet the minimum criteria established by the SFSC Foundation. Please use the following link to access the SFSC Foundation information <http://www.southflorida.edu/student/services/financialaid/Scholarships.aspx>

Additional AFC Requirements:

- Applicants for the AFC Foundation Scholarship must complete the same application process as listed above for the \$150 scholarship.
- The Applicant *must have completed* at least 6 credit hours or 240 clock hours per term at SFSC prior to the AFC Foundation Scholarship.
- The Recipient will be chosen by the AFC Scholarship Committee who will then make a recommendation to the SFSC Scholarship Committee.

Application Information:

- The AFC Foundation Scholarship is only awarded once a year

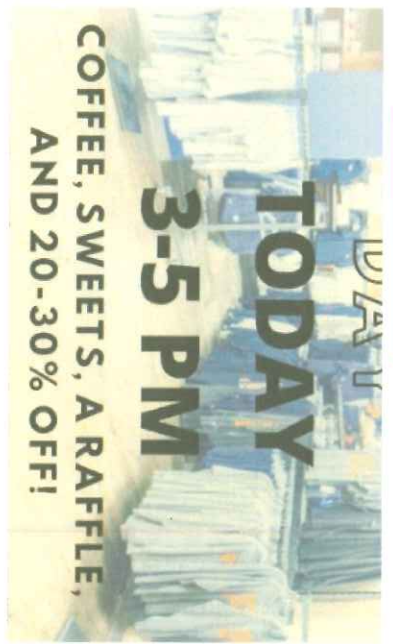

BYLAWS**

Article I NAME

The name of this organization shall be the South Florida State College (SFSC) Chapter of the Association of Florida Colleges (AFC).

Article II PURPOSE

The purpose of the chapter is to actively involve individual AFC members in carrying out the goals and purposes of the AFC Association. It encourages and promotes communication and interaction among employees, college trustees, and retired members.

Article III GOALS

1. To actively promote legislation that is beneficial to SFSC and individual members;
2. To encourage and promote opportunities for professional service and growth;
3. To improve articulation and cooperation among colleges and other interests;
4. To promote membership development, programs and activities that ensure an active and vital chapter;
5. To promote public understanding and support of the Florida College System;
6. To recognize and showcase exemplary SFSC practices, and
7. To maintain a fiscally sound organization.

Article IV MEMBERSHIP

1. Six classes of membership are available:
 - a) Individual: full-time employees and faculty, part-time employees, and adjunct faculty;
 - b) Contributing: SFSC District Board of Trustees (non-paying status);
 - c) Associate: any interested persons who support the mission of SFSC;
 - d) Retiree: any person who has retired from SFSC;
 - e) Life: available to any individual and retired members, and
 - f) Honorary Life: conferred on those persons who, in the opinion of the Chapter have made an outstanding contribution to AFC (non-paying status).
2. Only individual, contributing, retiree, life, and honorary life members have full rights of membership, to include voting and holding office.

Article V OFFICERS

1. The officers of the Chapter shall be: President, President-Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, Membership Co-Chairs, Legislative Representative, Ways and Means Chair, Publications Representative, and the Professional Development Chair.
2. The Executive Board shall be composed of the officers.
3. The officers shall be elected by a majority of voting membership through written or electronic ballot.
4. The officers shall serve for one year beginning January 1.
5. The offices may be filled by any voting AFC member of the SFSC Chapter.

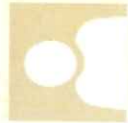
