2) Highlights/Announcements

- **Scholarships:** Call outs have been made to determine CCP scholarship opportunities (Chapter, Region, and Commission) to use in marketing efforts. Updates thus far:

 - Region III: Voting currently on one
- **New Offering:** A special one-day workshop “5G Power Skills for College Professionals”, a collaboration between AFC and Alph UMi, will be offered Sept. 19th in conjunction with the Sept. BOD meetings at Innisbrook. This will be the first offering of a new series of “CORE+” CCP workshops. CORE+ workshops are intended to present innovative and cutting edge professional development opportunities.
