# 1.0 Approval of Minutes

# 1.1 Approval, Policy & Advocacy Meeting Minutes, February 6, 2014

<u>Action:</u> Upon a motion by Dr. Katherine Johnson and a second by Dr. Jeff Allbritten the minutes of the February 6, 2014 meeting of Policy & Advocacy Committee were approved without objection.

## 2.0 Substantive Issues

Dr. Jim Henningsen reported the Chancellor's office has drafted an amendment to SB 1148. Dr. Ed Massey encouraged the presidents to take their time and talk to the appropriate legislators and staff members. He also stated it is important to answer the questions that the legislators are asking. Dr. Henningsen added talking points are being crafted and welcomed input. This bill will be watched closely.

Dr. Henningsen reported a meeting has been set up to get clarification on the tech center bill. Dr. Ed Meadows reported Dr. Belle Wheelan is willing to submit a letter to the Council regarding the transfer of credentials.

Dr. Henningsen reported the performance funding model update has been sent out. There is still interest in this on the Senate side, but not on the House side.

Mr. Matthew Holliday reported the Dream Act bill was heard this week.

The bill regarding veteran fees has passed.

The PECO proposal is moving along; however, it does have amendments.

Mr. Holliday reported the initial budget numbers have been released.

Ms. Stacey Webb reported textbook affordability remains important to the Governor.

She also reported Senator Legg is open to listening to the concerns regarding collegiate high schools. The penalty language is still in the bill; however, it now includes the school districts.

Dr. Jim Henningsen adjourned the Policy and Advocacy Committee meeting at approximately 9:07 a.m. without objection.
