1.0 Approval of Minutes

1.1 Approval, Policy & Advocacy Meeting Minutes, December 4, 2014

2.0 2015 Substantive Issues

Dr. Probstfeld reported several meetings have been held with Senate and House leadership. She suggested the \$100 million budget request for new money be divided as follows:

Equity-\$35 million Performance-\$30 million Workforce expansion-\$35 million

<u>Action:</u> Upon a motion by Mr. John Grosskopf and a second by Dr. Ed Meadows the \$100 million budget request to be divided as outlined above was approved by without objection.

Dr. Probstfeld referred to the handout entitled <u>Workforce Program Needs Summary</u> (Attachment A.) She added this will be shared with legislators.

She also stated the colleges have been asked for information on programs that have been closed in the last couple of years. This request will be sent to the colleges.

Dr. Probstfeld reported apprenticeship and articulation legislation are expected this session. She reminded the presidents that there is not a policy platform this session, but instead a policy statement. Dr. Probstfeld read the policy statement.

Mr. Steve Schroeder reported the lobbyists are currently monitoring 31 bills. The deadline for bill drafting is January 23.
